

Teaching Intentions	<p>Students will learn</p> <p>How to recognise that they can make choices</p> <p>About what they like and dislike</p> <p>How to take part in discussions with one other person and the whole class</p> <p>How to identify some of the influences on choices</p>
Starter	<p>Discuss learning intentions</p> <p>Choices game</p>
Main Session	<p>Discuss likes and dislikes, ask each student to state I like.... and I dislike.....</p> <p>Christmas and Birthday Wish activity</p> <p>Discuss why people make certain choices and what can influence those choices.</p> <p>Student handout -Di Lemma has a Di Lemma</p>
