

Right or Wrong quiz

Key Stage 2
What is right or wrong,
fair or unfair

Instructions

Time- 30 Minutes

Get the student to use the worksheet and decide whether they think the situations in the scenarios are right or wrong or they may be unsure.

Get students to discuss the possible consequences of some of the things they think are wrong.

Individual/group work: Students can work on this on their own or in groups and tick the right, wrong or unsure boxes on the worksheet.

Class work: This activity can also be done as a class activity using the right, wrong or unsure cards. The students can hold up the right or wrong card when a scenario is read out to them.
