

Community activity

Instructions

Time- 30 Minutes

Ask the students what they think the word community means?
Investigate the meaning of the word.

Try to get students to think of as many different people that can be part of a community and indeed what a community is made of.

Some ideas are listed below, (however, the list is not limited.) For the purpose of the exercise the list can be displayed to students for them to then select which ones they think are linked to community.

- Old People
- Children
- Parents/ grandparents
- Young Parents
- Different religions/
religious groups or leaders
- Different Nationalities
- The Police
- Community Workers
- Local Shops
- Schools
- Bus/ travel facilities
- Neighbourhood watch



ALTERNATIVELY, the students are expected to create their own list of who they know in their community. From the lists created students can either write down the names of the groups they think make up a community or a cut and paste exercise from magazines will serve to add visual illustration of community. Using the diagram, or a similar one, students will fill in the circles with the groups they have decided upon.
