Starter	<p>Discuss learning intentions Restrictions game- students needs to pick out the pictures which show the products that may have an age restriction attached to them</p>
Main Session	<p>Discuss the products that may have age restrictions attached to them. Discuss why they may have these restrictions Discuss the harmful effects of some of these products How Old game- Students must match the age to the product Student handout-Di Lemma goes to a fire work display.</p>
