

# Fair or Unfair quiz

Key Stage 3  
What is right or wrong,  
fair or unfair

## Instructions

Time- 15 Minutes

Get the student to use the worksheet and decide whether they think the situations in the scenarios are fair or unfair or they may be unsure.

Students may find it easier to understand words such as Right/Good/kind or Wrong/ Bad/Unkind. All words have been included in the quiz.

Get students to discuss the possible consequences of some of the things they think are unfair and the feelings that may be involved.

**Individual/group work:** Students can work on this on their own or in groups and tick the fair, unfair or unsure boxes on the worksheet.

**Class work:** This activity can also be done as a class activity using the fair, unfair or unsure cards. The students can hold up the fair or unfair card when a scenario is read out to them

There is only one cake left and you haven't had one yet. Your sister or brother grabs it and eats it all. Is this Fair/ Good / Right/ kind or Unfair/ Bad/ wrong/ unkind?

The shopkeeper will not help you or mend it even though they broke it more than before. Is this Fair/ Good / Right/ kind or Unfair/ Bad/ wrong/ unkind?</p>
