

Making Choices game

Key Stage 4
Making Choices

Instructions

Time- 20 Minutes

Get the students to use the picture worksheet and decide which car they would prefer to buy if they could choose any one.

This should get the students thinking about the choices that they make and why they have made them.

Individual/group work: Students can work on this on their own or in groups.

Once the individuals or group have made their choices, ask the students why they decided to buy that particular car. What helped to influence their decisions? The groups decision?

Appearance?

Make/Brand

Environmental issues

What if they had seen the car on an advert on the television, would this make a difference?

Discuss why an item might be more expensive? I.e. quality, features, better make, branding, materials used to make it, size.
